Join students from Professor Aurelia Mouzet's FREN 459/559 course, Talk-it-OUT! Theatre for Social Justice, for a forum theater show and get ready to become spect-actors! This community outreach event, which is open to the general public, will include guest speakers from Iskashitaa Refugee Network and feature a performance from Barrio Boheme, a local Tucson band. A potluck dinner will take place before the speakers, so don't forget to bring a dish, dessert, or soft drink!

Talk-it-OUT! is an inquiry-based theatre workshop program that teaches students how to use interactive theatre performance to foster discussion and enhance the community's awareness of social justice issues.

Iskashitaa Refugee Network is an intergenerational network of volunteers and UN refugees who locate, harvest, and redistribute local produce which would otherwise go to waste. IRN creates opportunities to integrate UN refugees into the Southern Arizona community while educating the public, strengthening the local food system, reducing local food waste, and increasing food security.

Barrio Boheme is a three-member band. Jason, the keyboardist, Stephen, the guitarist, and Aurelia, lead singer, enjoy playing original music and covers.
